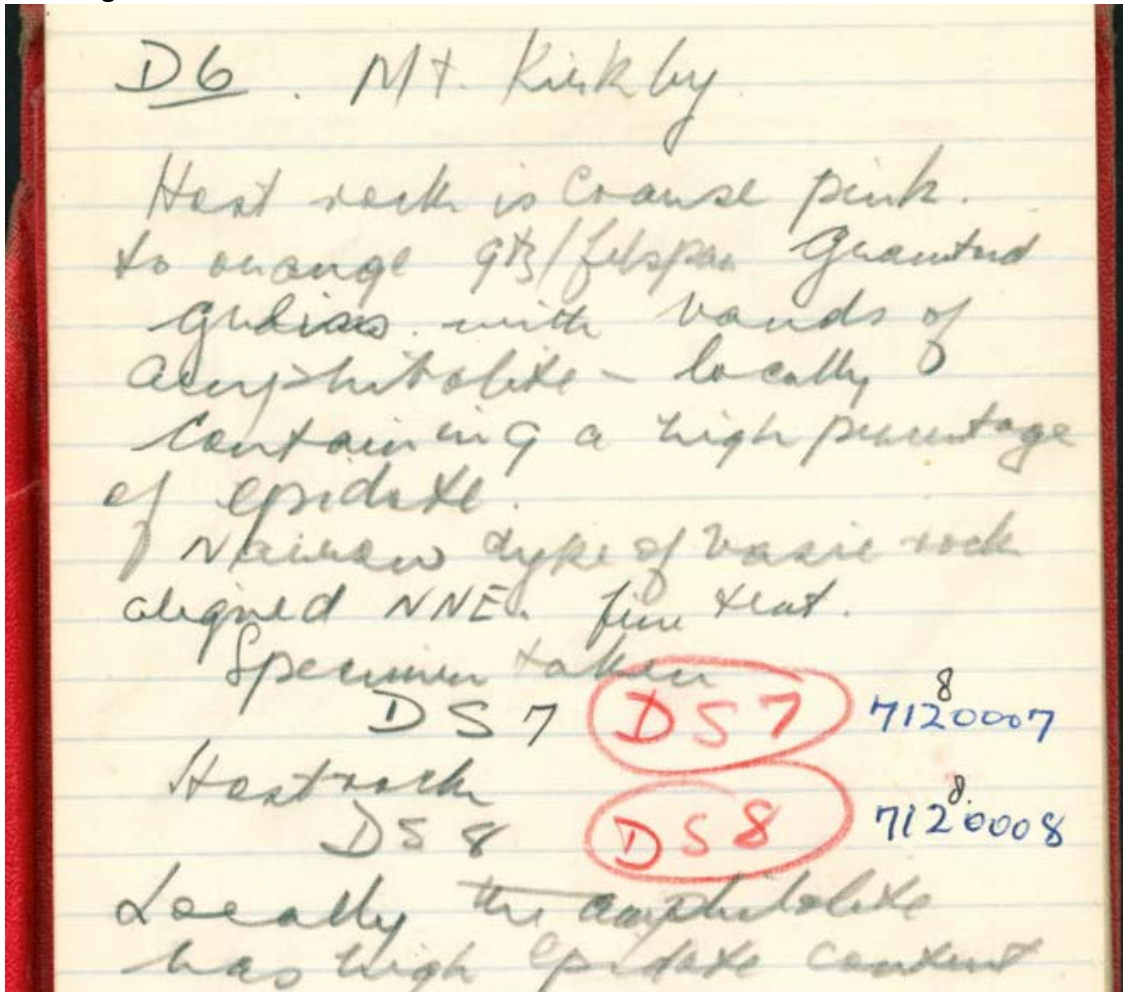

These notebooks are a little less structured than some of the others. The underlined D next to the place name e.g. D6 stands for the Point #

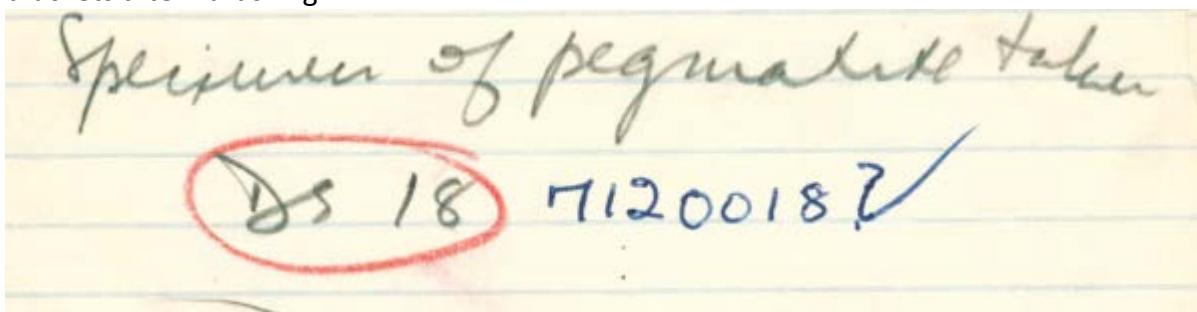
DS = the Rock Sample Number e.g. DS7 NOTE: later in the book it is written as Sp = specimen

The long number 71280007 = the Rock Store Number



To decode the number it is Year [71] Antarctic code [28] and the unique rock store identifier is the last four digits [0007]

There are some mistakes where the 28 has been left out. If you see this, please transcribe as written but place it between <sic> tags and write the corrected rock store number (with the 28) in brackets afterwards. E.g
