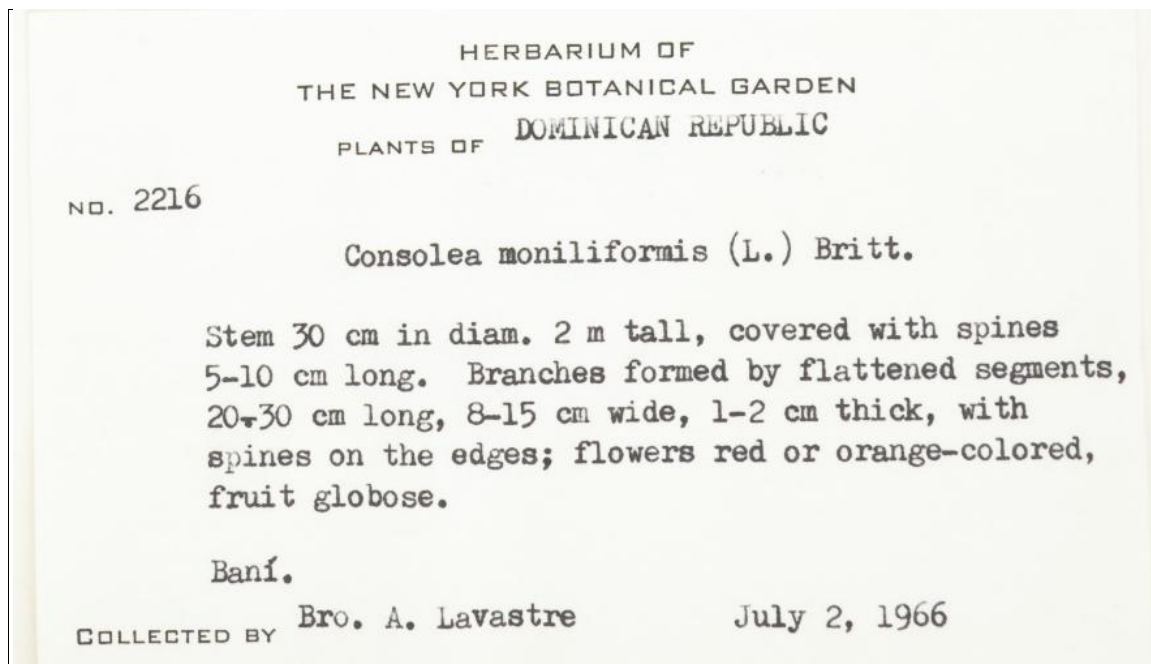
Who is the collector of this specimen?

The Correct answer is T. G. Yuncker.

G. R. Proctor identified the specimen but was not responsible for collecting it.

Also, note that this specimen sheet came from the T. G. Yuncker Herbarium, though the herbarium should not be confused with a collector either. In this case both collector and personal herbarium agree.

Question 2

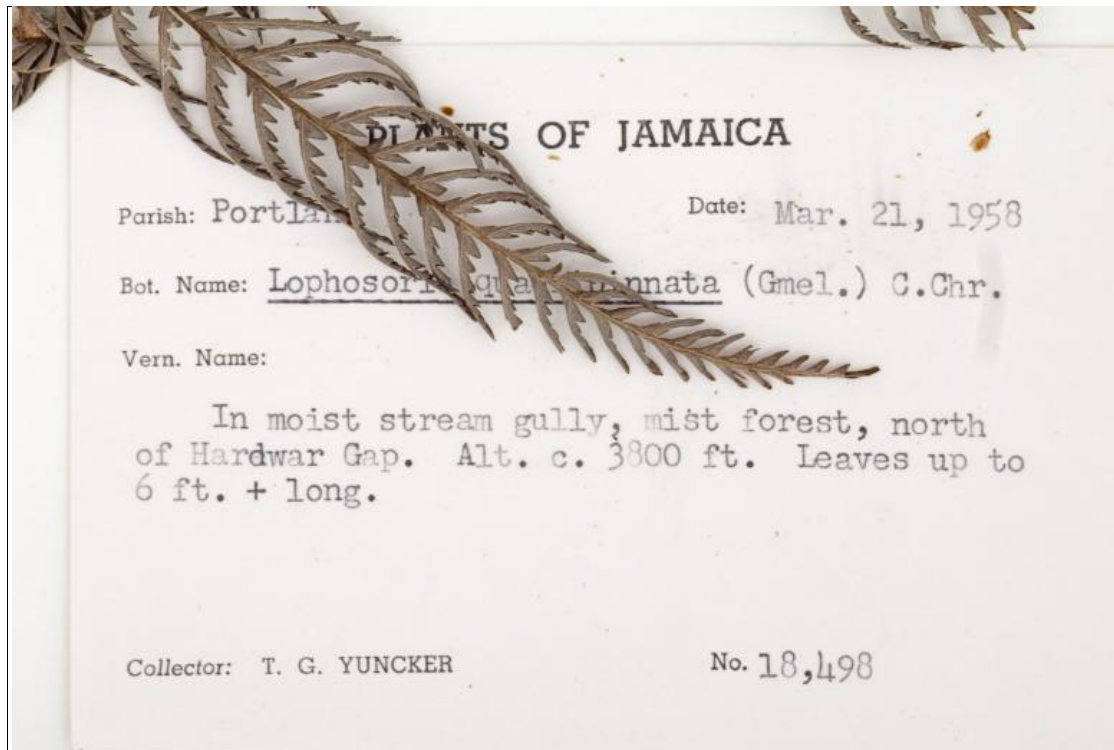


What is the habitat for this specimen?

This is a trick question! Although a long species description is recorded, this label shows no habitat.

It is unnecessary to transcribe the species description.

Question 3



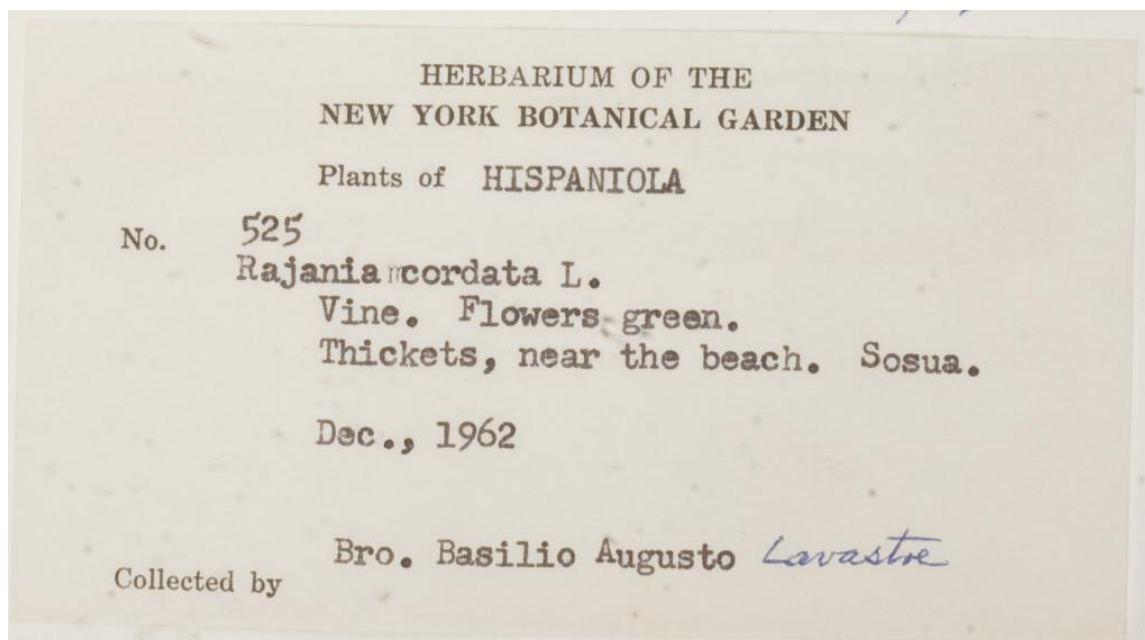
In what secondary administrative district was this specimen collected?

The answer is Portland Parish. Part of the name "Portland" was partially obscured by a frond, however with a little research or prior experience transcribing labels from Jamaica you can infer the ending.

Question 4

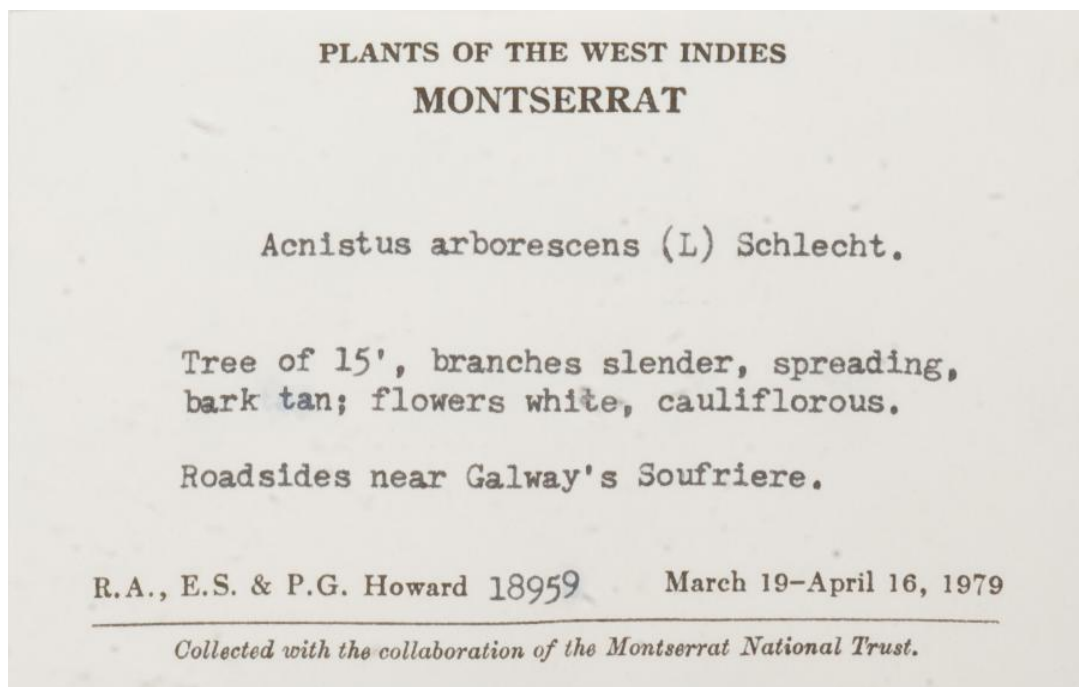


In which country was this specimen collected?

This specimen was collected in the Dominican Republic.

The label does not provide this information, but it can easily be searched for using Hispaniola and Sosua. Alternatively, Hispaniola would be entered into the locality field and a note would specify that there is no country listed.

Question 5



Who is the collector of this specimen?

There are actually 3 collectors of this specimen: R.A. Howard, E.S. Howard and P.G. Howard.

For the purposes of this project, however, we would like you just to record the first collector.

Answer: R.A. Howard
